VILLAGE OF ALLIANCE BYLAW #2024-07 WATERING RESTRICTION

WHEREAS, during the period of May 15th to October 1st of each year, watering of outside lawns and gardens shall not be allowed between the hours of 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. each day.

NOW THEREFORE, watering of outside lawns and gardens with municipally supplied water shall be allowed by all Owners, Tenants or Lessees only on specific days of the week according to their street address pursuant to the following schedule:

1. Odd-numbered addresses (those ending with 1, 3, 5, 7, or 9; **Watering permitted Wednesday, Friday and Sunday**)
2. Even-numbered addresses (those ending with 0, 2, 4, 6, or 8; **Watering permitted Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday**)
3. That all commercial, industrial and institutional properties shall follow the same watering restriction schedule.
4. In cases of extreme drought when reservoir levels become critically low, a total watering ban, will be imposed according to the direction of the Public Works Foreman or their designate.

EXEMPTIONS AND SPECIAL CASES

1. The provisions of this bylaw shall not apply to the following water users which rely upon the steady supply and use of water: Nurseries, parks, playing fields and public gardens, where failure to water would result in a permanent loss of plant material.
2. A person may:
 - a. Water flowers/shrubs/trees/vegetables at any time, provided that watering is done by hand using a hose with a shut off nozzle or a handheld container.
 - b. Water new trees and shrubs during installation and for the following 14 days using hand held nozzle.

A person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw by doing any act or thing that is prohibited, or by failing to do any act or thing that is required, is guilty of an offence and liable under summary conviction to pay a fine of not less than \$100.00 and not more than \$2,500.00

Residents and businesses who have video surveillance technology can choose to sign up for a free CAPTURE account that lets police know they are ready to help.

Once you create your account, officers can use it to contact you for help during ongoing criminal investigations. If a crime occurs in your area, an officer may request to view your surveillance footage for assistance.

The following are PERMITTED during this Fire Advisory:

- burning barrels equipped with a metal mesh screen.
- safe wood campfires in approved fire pits on private lands and in campgrounds.
- portable propane fire pits.
- gas or propane stoves and barbeques, including briquettes.
- pellet style electric smokers.
