ALLIANCE LAND USE BYLAW

INTERPRETATION:

CORNER LOT means a lot at an intersection of two or more roads or highways, or a road and a highway; **FENCE** means a vertical physical barrier constructed for visual screening, sound abatement or security;

SECTION 3.2 DEVELOPMENT NOT REQUIRING A DEVELOPMENT PERMIT

4) The erection or construction of gates, fences, walls or other means of enclosure (other than on corner lots or where abutting on a road used by vehicular traffic) less than 1.0m (3.28 ft.) in height in front yards and less than 2.0m (6.6 ft.) in side and rear yards, and the maintenance, improvement and other alterations of any gates, fences, walls or other means of enclosure.

SECTION 6.9 FENCES, HEDGES AND WALLS

- 1) Notwithstanding any other regulation respecting required yards in this Bylaw, a fence, hedge or wall may be constructed along a boundary line of a lot or immediately adjacent to a main building.
- 2) No fence, wall, hedge or other enclosure shall be higher than:
 - a) 2 m (6.6 ft.) measured as the average elevation from the ground, except
 - b) 1 m (3.28 ft.) within a required front yard.
