POLICY: The Village of Alliance Council believes that for safety and enjoyment of all patrons

the following regulations will be applied while using the ice rink.

PURPOSE: To establish clear guidelines for all ice rink patrons.

PROCEDURE:

• All peoples skate at their own risk

- Children under 10 years of age MUST wear a helmet (helmets are highly recommended for all skaters)
- Children under 5 years must be accompanied on the ice by an adult at all times
- All Patrons must wear ice skates on the ice at all
- No pushing
- No digging holes or damaging of the ice or barriers
- No sitting on the barriers
- No food, drinks, texting, smoking or video games to be used while on the ice
- No offensive or abusive language
- Please be courteous and respectful of all patrons and staff
- The ice surface may be uneven or wet depending on weather; as such, caution must be exercised.
- Intoxicated patrons will be removed from the ice or refused entry.
- The Alliance Arena Board reserves the right to remove patrons from the ice if it deems there is a risk to the safety of other patrons or the individual.
- Patrons disobeying the instructions of rink and staff and/or posted signs will be asked to leave the ice rink.
